Applications are invited for a three-day workshop on Preventive Conservation and Care of Cultural Collections that will provide an overall perspective on all agents that can have an impact on museum collections.

The workshop will discuss risk management, pest management and disaster management, as well as the needs for lighting, storage, art handling and exhibitions. In this day and age of natural disasters and climate change, it is essential to be prepared for all unforeseen eventualities.

INSTRUCTORS

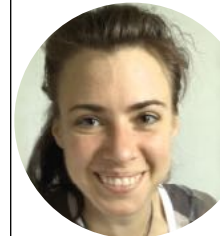
The instructors have given workshops on Preventive Conservation in many temperate zones over the past decade.
